

BFUMC YOUTH - Tentative Summer Scheduling (So Far):

May 2nd – LAST SCHOOL SESSION RECHARGE: We will meet, hang out, have some fun, enjoy the special church activities for last Recharge, and talk about what you want to do this summer.

After May 2nd – SUMMER PROGRAMMING: We WILL still continue Wednesday programming from 6 – 7:30 (May change depending on what we are doing that Wednesday) with both the middle and high school. This summer we will have a mix of class discussions, outings, games, and mission work activities. Both our middle and high school groups will join together on outings and mission work activities and some class discussions, but will have separate, group specific class discussions at times as well. We have some plans already, and will plan our summer as it goes and as the group comes up with ideas. Stay tuned for summer Wednesday scheduling and mini-outings.

May 6th (2pm-4pm) – BAZOOKA BALL AT CROSSINGS: Meet at church at 1:00 pm. We must have waiver forms filled out for this per Crossings Camp requirements. Please get your form filled out and returned by next Wednesday.

June 17th (the week of) – BATON ROUGE MISSION TRIP: Plans are being made by the church mission team as we speak about a week-long mission trip to Baton Rouge to help rebuild/repair housing from flooding. This mission trip is sanctioned by the Methodist Church and includes housing and meals. The church mission team has reached out to any youth that want to go. Those aged 16 and up do not require a guardian to attend with them. Those aged below 16 can still go given a parental guardian attends. Unfortunately this trip coincides with Crossings Church Camp but both will be equally fulfilling. Pricing has not been determined as of yet but there will be fundraising to help cover expenses.

June 22nd – 24th – CROSSINGS CHURCH CAMP: We are in the process of quickly making plans for church camp at Crossings. Given all goes as planned, there will be some forms that must be filled out for those that plan to attend. This camp is for students going into 7th grade and up. We ask all youth and parents to cooperate in getting all paperwork finished as quickly as possible so we can plan accordingly. Pricing and fundraising details will be to come but our plans are to cover all costs if possible through our specific church youth camp fund and fundraising.

June 25th – 29th – DAYSHORE CAMP: This camp is for ages 7 – 12 and is held all day at Pleasant Grove UMC. This would be an option for our new youth group members that are in going into 6th grade. The church has graciously set aside a fund to help pay \$100 per youth member towards any church camp a youth member attends including Day Shore. Please see the youth council for more details.

July 6th – 9th – CHRYSALIS: For those youth that have not attended Chrysalis, what an experience!! Just ask some of the ones that have already went. We will be hearing a little from these attendees in class soon and their experiences on the Chrysalis walk. If you are interested in being sponsored for the Chrysalis flight, or wish to help work the flight if you have already attended, we will need to get some paperwork filled out for you. Chrysalis is for sophomores in high school to sophomores in College.
