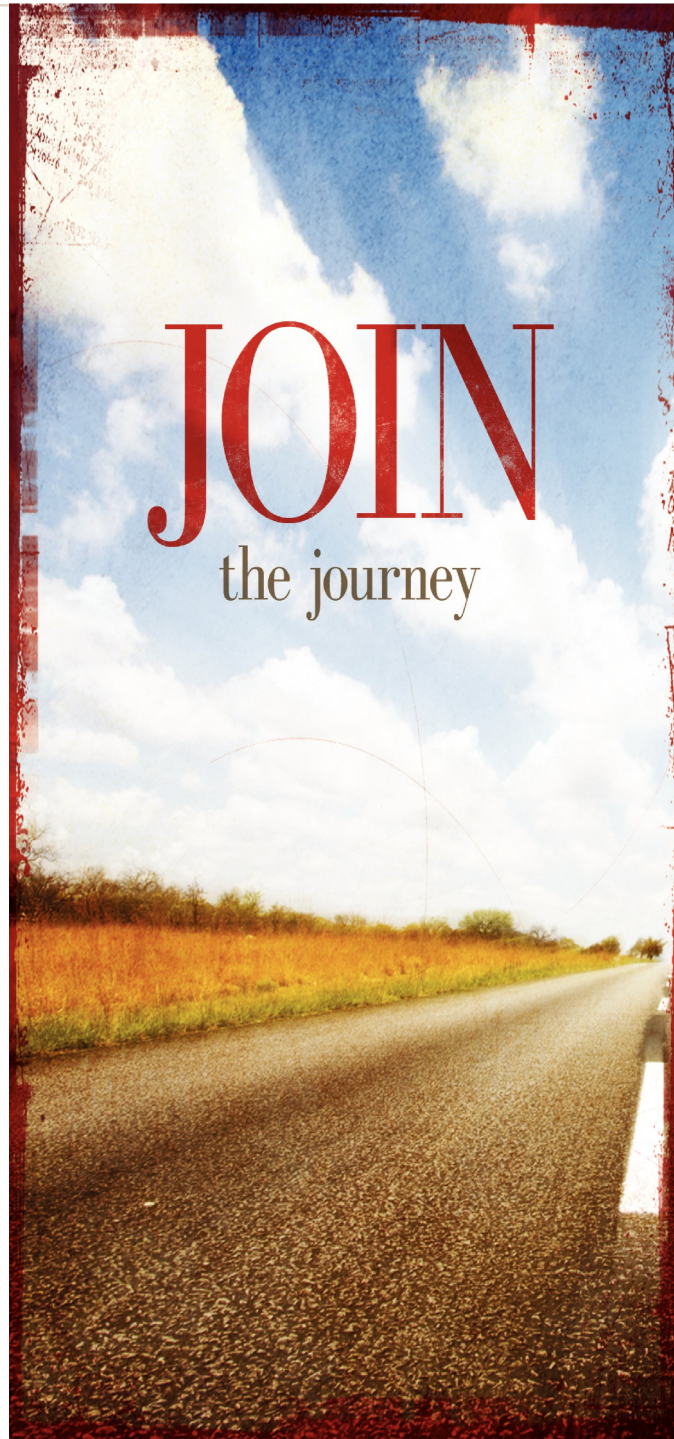

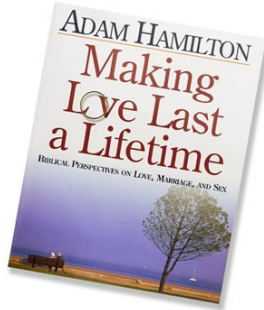

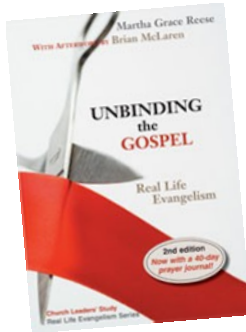
Class List for Adults



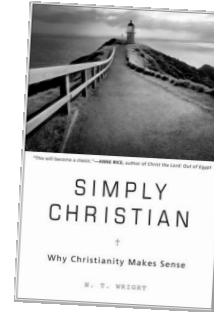
Rick and Jennifer Rodriguez will be the group leaders for this study of the Biblical perspective on love, sex and marriage. This small-group study provides the components to

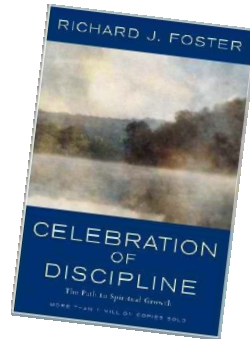

Wright makes the case for Christian faith from the ground up, so this is a great case for those who are curious and want to know more about what it means to be a Christian, whether you are new to the church or have been in a church all your life!



Sharon Perry and Susan Engle will lead this small group study in what John Wesley called a "means of grace." We will look at various spiritual disciplines practiced through the years to deepen our relationship with God. This book by Richard Foster is considered a classic in spiritual practices of the Christian faith.
